

Teaching Young Chefs

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We decided to investigate about the eating habits in young children between 5 and 11 nowadays as well as why they have acquired them. The research was done among children who live in Rosario, a city located in Colonia, Uruguay. We also detected a lack of knowledge about a healthy and balanced diet and so our purpose was to help them to be aware of it. As a result of this, we set our objectives on determine how these habits actually are to be able to establish those needed for a reasonable good nutrition.
