To design the algorithm, a convolutional neural network and image processing techniques were used. Through these methods, the outline of the person in question was created, and this outline was optimized by a quadratic function to create a more simplistic representation, which can be interpreted in a variety of different ways. Furthermore, by analyzing the frames continuously, it is possible to graph how the posture of the person changes in real time. Finally, by simplifying the program into various functions and modules, it was possible to make it more accessible for the public, both for developers, and other professionals that are not specialized in computer programming.
