

Healing From Within: Amniotic Fluid as a New Solution for Diabetic Wounds

In today's world, 1 in 9 people all over the world suffer from diabetes. Out of those people, 1-3 in 9 experience something called diabetic wounds. The final experiment run was testing amniotic fluid against a negative control, which was saline, and a positive control, which was clindamycin, an antibiotic. Areus or if the amniotic fluid used for testing had a specific gene or bacterial strain that didn't affect the S. Areus like predicted.
